Being reasonable with technology: a way forward

Contemporary philosophical debate on technology is vibrant and has acquired a new relevance and urgence considering the new advancements in technology especially A. I.

The positions in the debate are quiet extreme in that they give too little or too much consideration to human agency with respect to technology. In this paper I will develop a golden mean approach, based on one of the central tenets of Analytic Thomism namely that reason has fourfold relationship with order, that gives human agency the proper weight. In this way a path to more reasonable dealings with technology both on the individual and on the social and political level is opened.
